#### Description

Task Leader: PMBret; Participants: CNR, UOA, FAO, Trust-IT;

This task ensures the knowledge transfer of the project exploitable results to key stakeholders. Particular focus is put on the education of the members of the PMBret Innovation cluster, all working closely in the marine or maritime area.

The task foresees the organization of two dedicated local f2f training workshops with the aim of enabling uptake of BlueBRIDGE services and of collecting interest and training requirements of end-users on the project solutions. All actors engaged through the workshops could then potentially apply to become an Interested Party. PMBret ensures the active engagement of at least 5 new Interested Parties during the project lifetime. This activity is documented in task T2.1. Workshop feedback will be analysed in order to establish a generic methodology to be transferred to other European maritime clusters. All the training material developed for the workshops (in French and English) will be used to populate the e-Training area of the BlueBRIDGE web portal enriched by the material developed for the training courses delivered in WP8. Topics include business benefits of the solutions and market perspective and a guide on the available resources explaining how to access them, as well as domain specific models and how to use them. In addition 2 webinars, exploiting specific media channels (e.g. Channels.org), complement the knowledge transfer activity in order to educate a wider audience.
